What is the purpose of the MOU between the American Red Cross and Trail Life USA?

The MOU aims to strengthen the relationship by providing health and safety training at discounted prices to *Trail Life USA* members.

What types of training courses are available?

The American Red Cross offers a variety of health and safety training courses, including:

- First Aid, CPR, and AED
- Lifeguarding
- Babysitting Training
- Wilderness and Remote First Aid

How can Trail Life USA members access these training courses?

Members can access training in three ways:

1. **Contact the Red Cross training services or your Red Cross Representative** to schedule sessions delivered by certified Red Cross instructors. Call us at **1-800-567-1487** or fill out the [webform](#).
2. **Becoming certified instructors themselves** and establishing a Licensed Training Provider (LTP) Agreement with the Red Cross. Call us at **1-855-560-0067** or fill out the [webform](#).
3. **Community courses** are also available for individual enrollment by visiting www.redcross.org/takeaclass
4. *What discounts are available for Trail Life USA?*
 - **30% off** the current Full-Service pricing for Training Services delivered onsite by Red Cross instructors (minimum of 8 participants).
 - **30% off** the LTP Courses for Licensed Training Providers.

What is a Licensed Training Provider (LTP)?

An LTP is an entity authorized by the Red Cross to use Red Cross course materials and certified instructors to conduct training courses. ***Trail Life USA*** Troops or Sponsors can become LTPs to offer training directly to their members.

How can Trail Life USA become a Licensed Training Provider?

To become an LTP, a council must:

- Meet the prerequisites: Have at least one staff member or volunteer willing to become a certified Red Cross instructor.
- Ensure the candidate meets the Red Cross instructor certification requirements depending on the type of course.
- Complete the Instructor Certification Course: The candidate must enroll in and successfully complete the Red Cross Instructor Certification Course, which includes both online and in-person components. Call us at **1-855-560-0067** or fill out the [webform](#).
- Enter into a Licensed Training Provider Agreement: Once certified, the council must enter into an agreement with the Red Cross to use approved materials, maintain accurate training records, and comply with policies and procedures. Call us at **1-855-560-0067** or fill out the [webform](#).
- Set up training logistics: The initial cost to start up a new LTP includes purchasing equipment, materials, and supplies to conduct classes, and the cost of training individuals as American Red Cross Instructors.
